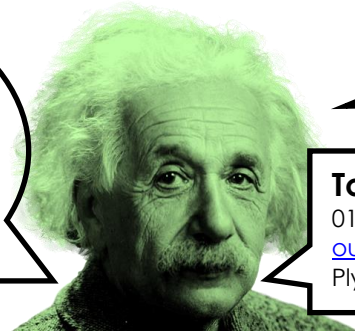

Mentor Twilight: Supporting NQTs to Meet the Needs of Pupils with SEMH

Delivered by an experienced school leader, who has also worked as a Senior Lecturer in Initial Teacher Training. Links will be made to teacher standards, but the focus will be on supporting mentors to help NQTs reflect on practice, build resilience and engage with mentoring, after a challenging year with limited time in the classroom due to Covid-19.

NQT Twilight 1: Professional Responses to Challenging Behaviour

An engaging presentation, full of ideas to challenge your thinking about the role of a classroom teacher as you leave behind the days of being a trainee teacher. The session is based on real life examples, with a focus on helping you to feel more confident, positive and excited about meeting the needs of all the young people in your class.

NQT Twilight 2: Strategies for Managing Behaviours that Challenge

Honest advice from an experienced teacher on managing low, medium and high level behaviours. This session will help you think about what might be causing certain behaviours and what you can do to manage them. The session includes plenty of opportunity to discuss and problem-solve particular issues in your classroom.

NQT Twilight 3: Planning to Teach - Taking Ownership Of That Tricky Class

Every teacher has a class that challenges, lessons they lack confidence with or pupils that frustrate them. The session involves an open and honest discussion to start identifying the barriers you are facing, to share good ideas with colleagues and to ensure you go away with a plan to "crack that difficult class"!

NQT Twilight 4: Understanding Pupils' Needs - Drivers of Behaviour

Inclusion is high on schools' agenda and funding changes mean schools are having to meet the needs of children with more and more complex needs. This session will begin to identify some drivers of behaviours. The session will encourage you to think about the needs of the pupils in your class, what strategies might support children with different needs and what changes can you make in your classroom.

NQT Twilight 5: Developing as a Teacher of Pupils with SEMH Needs

Take time to reflect on your own practice and develop skills of observation and self-reflection to develop practice. This session also introduces wider approaches schools are taking to meeting the universal, targeted and specialist social and emotional health needs of children in their care, such as working restoratively or embedding nurture principles. Aimed at colleagues who are keen to develop classroom practice and those interested in SEN or school leadership.
